

## ***Expanding Health Care Preparedness***

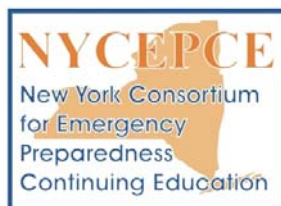
